FERMENTATION:

This wine is a combination of whole cluster press and saignee juice. It was fermented entirely in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures to preserve aromatic freshness.

AGING:

After its 30-day fermentation the majority of the wine (81%) was aged in stainless steel tanks; a small amount (19%) was aged in neutral oak barrels for two months to add texture and complexity.

2021 HARVEST

The 2021 Vintage was one for the books, and not just because we were celebrating our 50th Anniversary! The growing season got an early jump thanks to the warmer than normal temperatures, and one of the driest March and Aprils ever recorded. Our vineyards endured remarkably well through a rain event right at bloom followed by recordbreaking heat for 3 consecutive days. Mother Nature graced us with quite literally a perfect harvest and truly incredible fruit quality that we are beyond excited about.

VINEYARD

The grapes for this wine come entirely from our LIVE certified estate vineyards in the Northern Willamette Valley.
